Please arrive at Rosedale Center wearing your concert attire.

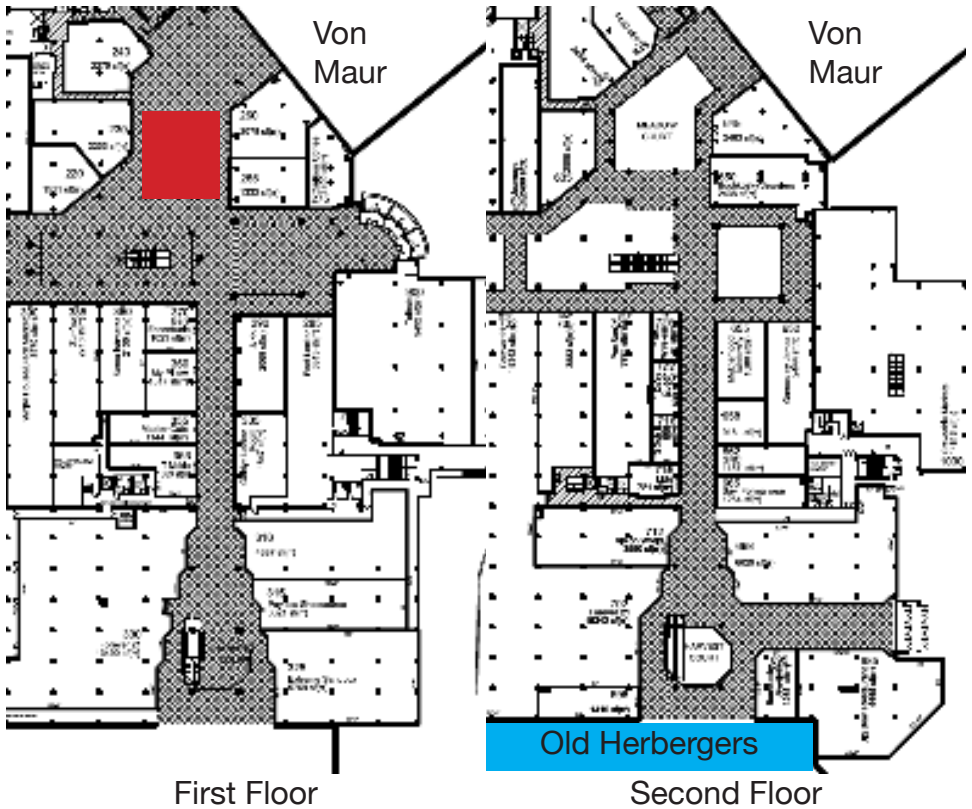
**All Orchestras:** The dress code for the Play-a-thon concert is all black with a pop of holiday color i.e. red, green, blue, gold or silver. We will be selling red MYS scarves at the Play-a-thon for \$8!



**Please do not wear the following items at an MYS concert:** Tight-fitting skirts, side slits on skirts, jumpers, plunging necklines, backless dresses, sleeveless or strapless dresses or blouses, jeans, suspenders, leggings, open-toed or tennis shoes.

### What to bring to Rosedale Shopping Center:

**Music stands will not be provided, so please bring your own.** Be sure to coordinate with your stand partner as to who is bringing the stand. Remember your instrument and music! It is your responsibility as a musician to have extra strings, mutes, reeds, or any other miscellaneous items for your instrument.



**Arriving at Rosedale Shopping Center:**

Students should be dropped off at the entrance by Talbots. Students will be checked in by MYS staff and volunteers in the blue highlighted area. Parking is available at the mall but gets more limited as the day goes on.

**During the Performance:**

Students will wait to go onstage in the blue highlighted area. You will leave your belongings including cell phones and electronic devices in the blue highlighted area. Belongings will be looked after by a MYS staff member or volunteer.

**After the Performance:**

Students must remove belongings from the blue highlighted area following their performance to make room for the next orchestra. Students are free to watch the other orchestras. Please note that there is limited seating so be prepared to stand or watch from the 2nd level. If you would like to bring a seat of your own, you are welcome to. We recommend that you watch the performance from the second level upstairs.
